NRO NC Election



October 2024

- We send three representatives to the Number Resource Organisation Number Council (NRO NC), which serves as the Address Supporting Organisation Address Council (ASO AC) at ICANN
- Two are elected, one is appointed by the RIPE NCC Executive Board
- This election is to fill one seat for a three-year term starting in January 2025 and ending in December 2027
- Sander Steffann stepped down from his seat earlier this year, ahead of the RIPE NCC Executive Board election. Thank you Sander!
- The other members are Hervé Clément and Constanze Bürger

Voter Registration and Eligibility



In order to be eligible to vote, you must:



Have registered for RIPE 89

You can be registered online or onsite



Registered to vote in the NRO NC election

Select the option to vote in the NRO NC election



Attended any meeting from RIPE 81-RIPE 88

Attended = Registered and checked-in



Checked-in for RIPE 89

You need to check in even if you're online!

Forgot to register to vote?



Onsite

- Go to the registration desk
- Ask them to register you for the election
- Make sure that you have been checked-in

Online

- Go to your personal options page, the link is in your registration email
- Select the option to vote in the NRO NC election
- Check yourself in!



Check whether you've checked-in



View the attendee list

If you don't see a green check mark next to your name:

ONSITE: Ask the Registration Desk staff to check you in

ONLINE: Go to your personal options page using your unique link. **Select the option to check-in.**

Troubleshooting: If you have chosen not to display your name on the attendee list, you will not see your name!

Here's what happens


You will receive an email from the NRO NC election team informing you that you are **not eligible**.

If you think this is a mistake, and that you are eligible to vote, you can **ask for a review** using the form. The link to the form is in the email.

The Review team will send you its decision.

VOTING INSTRUCTIONS

How to Vote



You will receive two emails from Assembly Voting

One email contains your unique voting link to the voting platform with a pre-filled code (Voting Code 1)

The other email contains your one-time pin code to access the voting platform (Voting Code 2)

You need both codes to access the system

Select the candidate of your choice and submit your vote!

Abstentions are noted but do not count towards the result.

You will receive two emails from Assembly Voting

Click on Vote Now

Each link is personalised

Voting Code 1 is pre-filled

If you're using Safari, you might need to copy and paste Voting Code 1

The system can be accessed on your preferred device with access to a browser. Please be aware that Internet Explorer cannot be used to access the system.

Please be sure to vote for the candidate of your choice or to select Abstain to ensure that your vote is registered. If you leave the platform before submitting your vote and confirming on the vote summary page, your vote will not be registered.

Paste your NRO NC Voting Pincode (Voting Code 2)

Go to the ballot to vote!

Select the candidate of your choice


Or you can abstain

Click on continue


Submit your vote!
