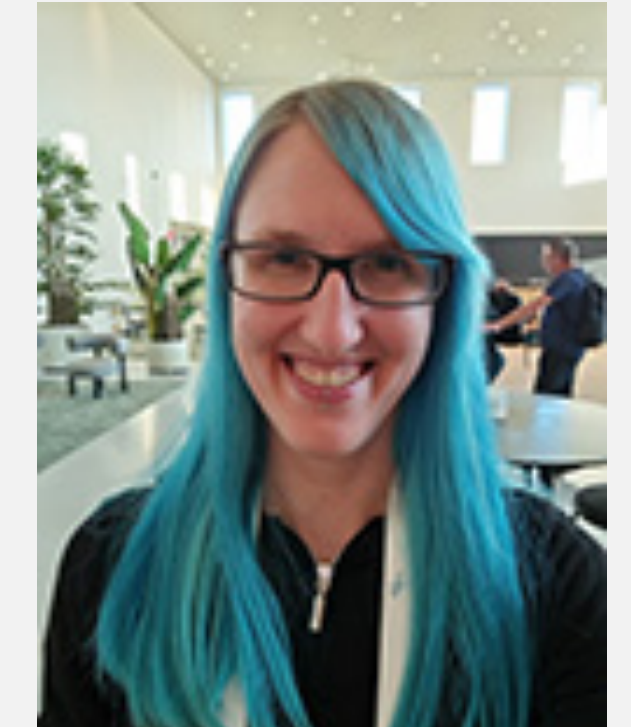

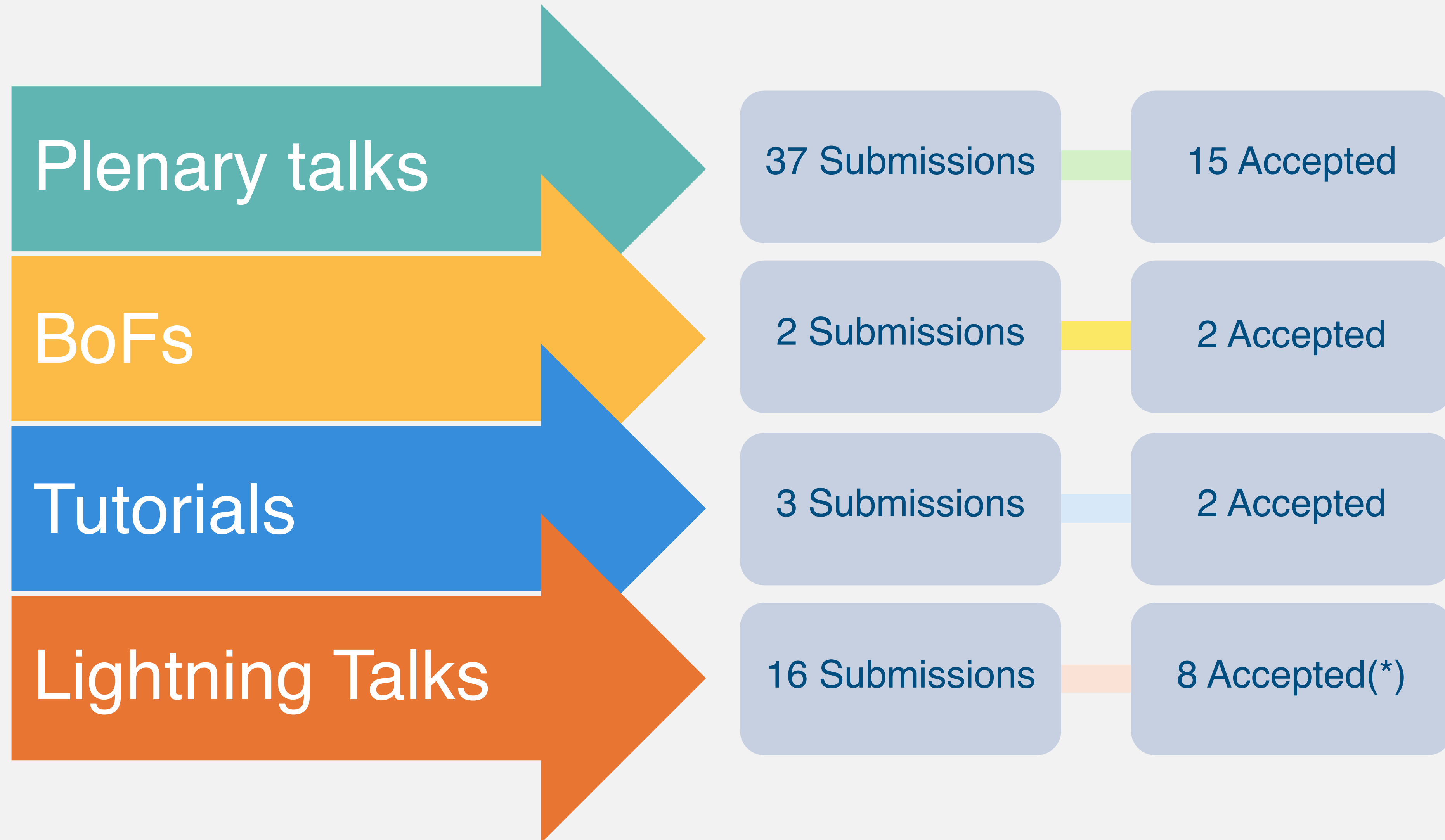

# Changes from RIPE88

- Explanation on **why** talks were rejected
  - It helps create more awareness
  - If after first deadline, there's a chance to re-submit
- New document: **RIPE-829**
- Updated submission guidelines



- RIPE Programme Committee Charter
- Changes include:
  - Removed reference to ENOG representative
  - A better definition of the different roles inside the PC
  - Potential financial support availability

# When AI will help your presentation

- AI can help when you use it to:
  - do spell check/grammar/autocomplete
  - write text that a human rewrites
- AI does **not** help when you use it to:
  - make AI art (distracting errors, possible IP issues for you)
  - write final text (long, boring, IP again)
  - do graphic design (hard to read)
