

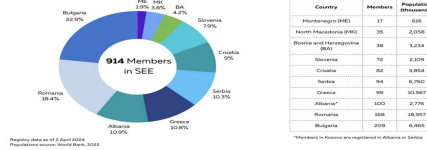


Figure 2: Overview of RIPE NCC Membership and population in the region

Please note: country codes in the RIPE Database (registry information) follow the ISO 3166-1 list for officially assigned country codes. Members in Kosovo are typically registered under the Albania country code (AL), but some are registered under the Serbian country code (RS). This is reflected in all data analysed for this article.

IPv6 Capability

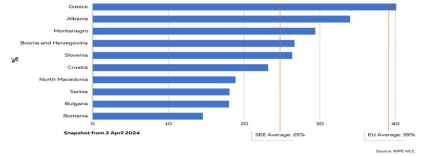
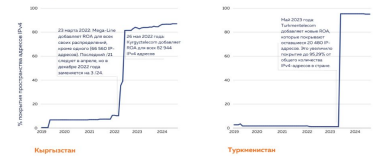


Figure 3: The percentage of IPv6-capable ASNs in SEE

On average, the percentage of IPv6-capable ASNs (defined here as the % of ASNs routing at least one IPv6 prefix) remains low in the region (around 25%) compared to the EU average (around 39%) as of April 2024 (see Figure 3).

% of IPv6-capable ASNs in South East Europe

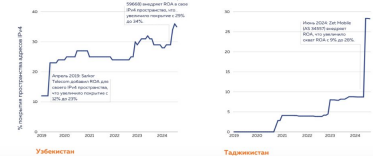


Уровень внедрения авторизации источника маршрута (ROA Coverage) в Центральной Азии



В Узбекистане уровень охвата ROA увеличился в апреле 2019 года, когда Sarkor Telecom внедрил ROA. Следующий скачок произошел в мае 2024 года, когда компания Tiplon Media также внедрила ROA. В Таджикистане, уровень внедрения увеличился на 10%, когда Zet Mobile (ранее известная как Tasfon) добавила ROA в свое IP пространство.
